


### How to Play:








### **RESUME ROAST 500**

overly complicated design/ font, columns in their resume that ATS cannot read








#### **WORKPLACE POTLUCK**

Practice your presentation, keep it concise, engage the audience with questions or relatable examples, and be confident






### INTERVIEW INVESTIGATION

demonstrating how your skills and experience align with the company's needs




